Address Change on Your My Number Card Following the New Residential Address System

[Start Date of Procedures: Tuesday, 13 January 2026] (Reservations will be accepted from Monday, January 5)

Due to the implementation of the New Residential Address System, residents who have a My Number Card will be required to have the address on their card updated. We kindly ask you to complete this procedure. As many residents will be affected, a temporary service desk will be set up at the Tokiwa Beppu Department Store, available by reservation. Significant and prolonged congestion is expected at the City Hall service counter (main building only), so we encourage you to make use of the temporary service desk.

◆When the procedure is completed by the applicant

- (1) My Number Card
- PIN for the Basic Resident Registration System (4-digit number)
- 3 Notification/Certificate Document (the enclosed A4sized document)
- ※If you wish to apply for the issuance of the Digital Certificate for Electronic Signature, please refer to the next section.

♦When the procedure is completed by a representative

In addition to items ①—③ listed on the left, please prepare the following:
④ Two identity verification documents of the representative

Two identity verification documents of the representative Must be valid and unexpired. (e.g., My Number Card, driver's license, passport, health

insurance card, with qualification confirmation, long-term care insurance card, pension handbook, etc.)

(5) <u>Letter of Attorney (Authorization Form)</u>
Required only when the representative resides in a different household. (See the reverse side.)

(Important notes) If the PIN does not match or if it is unknown, the representative will not be able to complete the procedure on the same day.

[Issuance of the Digital Certificate for Electronic Signature after the address update (Applicant only)]

If your My Number Card contains a Digital Certificate for Electronic Signature, you may complete the issuance procedure at the same time as the address update.

You will need the PIN for the Digital Certificate for Electronic Signature (6–16 alphanumeric characters).

*The certificate is not included on cards issued to those under 15 years old at the time of issuance or to those who opted not to have it installed.

(Important notes) The applicant must be present in person. The procedure cannot be completed by a representative on the same day.
